Information Sheet

- 1. Check in for Units participating in the Scout Show will be from 5:00-8:00 PM on Friday, April 30 and from 6:00-9:00 AM on Saturday, May 1. Final Troop Rosters are due at check-in. To the greatest extent possible, all participants shall check in with their unit.**
- 2. Beginning at 5:00 PM on Friday, April 30 and ending at 11:30 AM on Sunday, May 2; all traffic in camp will follow a one way traffic pattern. Traffic will enter at the main gate, proceed on the lower road to Randy Rowe lodge, turn left onto the upper road and follow the upper road around the Marlin Miller Conference Center to Washington Field, turn right and proceed to the alternate gate.**
- 3. Camp will be closed to vehicular traffic (except emergency and service vehicles) from 9:00 PM, Friday April 30 through 6:00 AM, Sunday May 2.**
- 4. Units may have an un-tethered equipment trailer in their designated camping area or display area provided there is adequate space in the area and the trailer is in placed before 9:00 PM Friday, April 30. Units setting up exhibits may do so from 6:00 – 9:00 PM Friday or early Saturday morning, however, exhibit materials should be transported to display areas Friday evening. Units wishing to set up on the morning of Saturday May 1 will have to carry their gear from a designated drop off location in camp or the parking lot to their designated camp site or display area.**
- 5. Between 8:00 PM, Friday April 30 and 6:00 AM, Sunday May 2, parking in the camp parking lot will be limited to one vehicle per participating unit, staff, and those needing handicapped parking. Due to the large volume of participants expected we ask that you honor these parking rules.**
- 6. Due to the nature of camp and spatial limitations; participating units should be prepared to set up their display and or camp on unlevel ground. Electricity will NOT be available; participating units should not have displays requiring power.**
- 7. Units will be given their Display Area and/or Camping Area assignments at check in or prior to, if available. Not all units will be assigned to campsites with platforms and tents so they should be prepared to tent on the ground with their own equipment.**
- 8. All campers and other participants are responsible for their own meals. Light breakfast and lunch faire will be available for purchase at the dining halls and or trading post. Chicken Barbeque will be served at dinner on Saturday, May 1. Tickets for BBQ must be purchased by April 23, 2010 – No Exceptions. Camp fires are permitted using existing fire rings or self contained units only. Units planning to cook their own meals should be equipped with camp stoves or other alternative food preparation equipment. Units will NOT be allowed to sell food to event attendees.**
- 9. It is anticipated that the lake will be available for Boy Scouts only (not Cub Scouts). A copy of last year's summer camp swim check was returned to each unit; these swim checks will still be valid for this event. There will be no opportunity to have swim tests executed at camp during or prior to this event. Any needed swim checks must be completed prior to the event at the responsibility of the unit/Scout.**
- 10. Departure time is out by 11:00 AM on Sunday. May 2. Camp awards, patches, and other materials will be handed out at check out after camp site inspections. Please plan your clean up accordingly.**
