WHAT IS THE TRAINER'S EDGE:

The Trainer's Edge replaces the Trainer Development Conference as the required train-the-trainer course for Wood Badge and Wolf's Lair staffs. The purpose of The Trainer's Edge course is to provide and help develop the platform skills of a trainer. It is meant to supplement the practice offered through Wood Badge and Wolf's Lair staff development, with a focus on the participant, while raising the level of skill a trainer brings to the staff experience. Only practice can polish these skills, but this course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

Any senior Boy Scout, Venturer or Varsity Team member and any Scout leader or committee member who instructs or presents information to the youth in their unit, or to the parents of the youth in their unit, can benefit from this course.

This course is required for N.Y.L.T. Staff (youth and adult) and Wood badge Staff.

All council training committee members and all district training team members who will be delivering training on all phases of the Scouting program should attend.
