Who May Attend Wood Badge

To attend a Wood Badge course, individuals must:

- ❖ Be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America. (Youth older than 18 may attend as long as the appropriate Youth Protection guidelines are followed. They do not need to be registered in an adult leadership role.
- ❖ Have completed the basic training courses for their Scouting position.
- ❖ Be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment. All participants are required to complete the Annual Health and Medical Record form (available at www.scouting.org).

NOTE>>>Individuals who have attended Wood Badge in the past (either Cub Scout Trainers' Wood Badge or Boy Scout Leader Wood Badge) may attend Wood Badge for the 21st Century provided that:

- 1) *They agree to write and work a Wood Badge for the 21st Century ticket;*
and
- 2) *They agree not to wear Wood Badge beads until they have satisfactorily completed their Wood Badge for the 21st Century ticket.*
