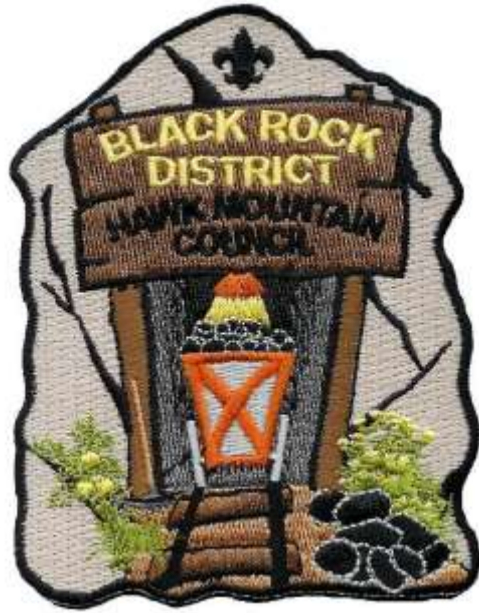

2012 CUB SCOUT KLONDIKE DERBY

PLEASE NOTE: This event will run RAIN or SHINE or SNOW. There will be no alternate date. We will cancel in the event of EXTREME weather and if it occurs, there will be no refunds. Boys and adults must be properly dressed for the weather. That means waterproof boots (absolutely no sneakers), ski hats to cover ears (why not decorate your ski hats at a den meeting to show some Cub Scout Spirit on the trails.) Each station will last approximately 20 minutes. There will be a hotdog and hot chocolate served for lunch. Other food must be brought by individual.

The cost is \$5.00 per boy and \$2.00 per adult leader. Please fill out the attached registration form completely and return it with payment to the Hawk Mountain Council - Beaver Family Service Center by January 20, 2012.

Check-in will be held in the Science and Technology Building (to the left of the lower parking lot by flag and monument). Please attempt to arrive about 15 minutes before the start time to allow for instructions. Please have your roster completed with all the boys' names, as well as any adult attending the event. This will help expedite the check-in process.

Registration Fee Covers the Following:

- Cub Scout – event, patch, hot dog and hot chocolate
- Leader – event and patch

Belt loops will not be given out at camp. Each pack will be responsible for supplying belt loops.

All Teams must be in groups of 8-10 boys. Smaller Groups will be combined to meet these numbers. This is done to assure the boys get adequate time at the Stations. Please be sure the boys conduct themselves according to the Cub Scout Oath. Not doing so will result in the Cub Scout being asked to leave the event.
