

Unit Pages: Finding a Unit and Becoming a Friend

1. Finding a Unit

a. From the Left Menu of the Council Homepage (hmc-bsa.org)

- Select Unit Information
- Select “Click to Search for a Unit” (by the green arrow)
- Enter the information you know about the unit and press “Begin Search”
- Click on the appropriate unit (you can click on the “header Row” to re-sort the results)

b. From the Right Hand Menu

- Select the appropriate District
- From the subsequent Right Hand Menu select “Units in the District”
- Click on the unit type/number from the list provided

2. To become a Friend (Note: You must have a MyCouncil account and be logged in)

- Click on the “Become a Friend” option found in the right hand margin on the unit web page



- b. Click on the "Submit a Friends Request" link (by the green arrow)
- c. On the next page read the Friends Request Agreement, Check the Yes, I Agree button and press Submit Request
