Wilderness first aid is needed for activities in remote areas such as hiking, climbing, camping, sailing, hunting, birding, or snowmobiling. Anyone living, working, traveling, or just enjoying the wilderness should be prepared to manage a medical emergency. Broadly defined, wilderness is a remote geographical location more than one-hour from definitive medical care.

Wilderness first aid is the immediate care given to an injured or suddenly ill person. It does not take the place of definitive medical care and consists only of giving assistance until a more advanced level of medical care, if needed, is obtain or until the chance for recovery without medical care is apparent.
